

Cowl with Chains

Yarn Along The Rockies 2017

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Finished Measurements:

11" wide and 24" long, worked in the round

Gauge:

4 sc in 3 inches, 2 stitches per inch

Yarn:

2 skeins Malabrigo Rasta 100% merino wool

Needles & Notions:

Hook N
Locking Stitch markers
Tapestry Needles

Abbreviations:

Ch = chain
FSC = Foundation Single Crochet
Sc = single crochet
Sts = stitches

Construction Notes

This simple cowl is crocheted and designed to be worn doubled, it makes a snug fit around anyone's neck and loosens up with time. You will feel bundled up in this wooly cowl with chains.

Pattern

Directions

Rnd 1: 5 FSC, ch48, 5 FSC, ch48

Rnd 2 : (Attach Chain to initial FSC with a single crochet (sc), ch1 ***, 5 sc , ch48) repeat

Rnd 3: (sc 1 into the marked chain from the previous row, 5 sc, ch48) repeat

Rnd 4: repeat Rnd 3 until you complete 17 rounds!

*** HINT - It is very easy to twist the cowl! I recommend marking the "chain 1" stitch with scrap yarn so it's easy to identify where to attach the next time you come around to the base and work your way around the cowl.

Finishing

Weave in ends.
Steam lightly and enjoy!
