Yarn:

1 skein of DK weight yarn (190 yds)
(Sample made in KFI Luxury Silk tonal, Color No. 105)

Needles & Notions:

Size H (5mm) Crochet Hook
Darning Needle

Abbreviations:

ch - Chain
ch-sp - chain space
sc - Single Crochet
dc - Double Crochet
hdc - Half Double Crochet
tc - treble crochet
V-stitch - dc, ch1, dc worked in same stitch
sp - Space
sk - Skip
sl-st - Slip Stitch
RS - Right Side
WS - Wrong Side
St(s) - Stitch/Stitches

Pattern

Round 1: Ch 4, V-stitch (dc, ch1, dc worked in same stitch) in the 3rd chain from join, ch 1, [sk 2 ch sts, dc in next ch, ch1, sk 2 ch sts, V-stitch in next ch, ch 1] repeat in brackets 32 times. Join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch 4.

Round 2: Ch 4, dc in sl st, ch 1, dc in the ch-sp of the V-stitch, ch1, [V-stitch in next single dc, ch 1, dc in the ch-sp of V-stitch, ch 1], repeat in brackets 32 times. Join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch 4.

Round 3: Sl st, ch 2, 5 tr in dc, [sc in ch-sp of V-stitch, 5 tr in dc] repeat 32 times. Join with sl st in 2nd ch of beginning ch 2.

Round 4: Ch 5, hdc in 3rd dc, ch 2, [tr in sc, ch 2, hdc in 3rd dc, ch 2] repeat 32 times. Join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch 5.

Round 5: Repeat round 2.

Round 6: Sl st, ch 4, V-stitch in next single dc, ch 1, [dc in the ch-sp of V-stitch, ch 1, V-stitch in next single dc, ch 1], repeat in brackets 32 times. Join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch 4.

Round 7: Ch 4, 2 dc in sl st, sc in ch-sp of V-stitch, [5 tr in dc, sc in ch-sp of V-stitch] repeat 32 times. 2 dc in the sl st at beginning of round, sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch 4.

Round 8: Ch 4, tr in sc, ch 2, [hdc in 3rd dc, ch 2, tr in sc, ch 2] repeat 32 times. Join with sl st in 2nd ch of beginning ch 4.

Round 9: Repeat round 6.

Round 10: Repeat round 2.

Round 11: Repeat round 3.

Round 12: Repeat round 4.

Round 13: Repeat round 2.

Round 14: Repeat round 6.

Finishing

Cut yarn and pull through remaining loop on hook.
Weave in the ends.
