## Finished Measurements:

54" long x 22" wide

## Gauge:

5.5 sts x 8 rows = 1" in Stockinette

*Meeting this exact gauge is not crucial, but any major differences will affect the size of the finished shawl.*

## Yarn:

Sock Blanks by Nikki

## Needles & Notions:

US 6 (4mm) Needles

Markers for marking right side

## Abbreviations:

BO bind off

CO cast on

inc increase

K, k knit

kfb knit into front and back of st

RS right side

sl3wyif slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn in front  
st(s) stitch(es)

WS wrong side

## About Nikki's Knots

This is a pattern that I have made multiple times because it's stylish, simple, and really shows off a great hand dyed yarn.

## Pattern

CO 5 sts

*Setup Rows:*

1: K1 KFB sl3wyif

2: Knit

3: K1 KFB knit to last 3 sl3wyif

4: Knit

*Body*

Repeat setup rows 3 and 4 until desired length.

*Bind Off*

Use the i cord Bind off method.

## Finishing

Weave in all ends. Wash and block to measurements, pinning top edge flat.
