

# Hemp Washmitt

Yarn Along The Rockies 2017

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## Finished Measurements:

Small- 6" around and 6" long  
Medium- 7" around and 7" long  
Large- 8" around and 8" long

## Gauge:

4 Back Loop Single Crochet (blsc) = 1"

## Yarn:

1 Skein Java 4oz 219 Yards  
Makes 2 Large Mitts  
Color: Pistachio (shown in large)  
Color: Desert Rose (shown in small)

## Needles & Notions:

Crochet Hook Size F, or size needed to obtain gauge  
Tapestry needle

## Abbreviations:

ch-Chain  
sc-Single Crochet  
dc-Double Crochet  
sp-Space  
sk-Skip  
St(s)- Stitch/Stitches  
\*\*Repeat from\*  
Sl St-slip stitch  
FLO-front loop Only  
BLO-Back Loop Only  
FPDC-Front post double crochet  
BPDC-Back post double crochet  
Blsc-Back loop single crochet  
sc decrease: insert hook in next st and then again in following st, yo and draw through all 3 loops.

## Pattern

### Cuff:

Double Crochet Foundation Row:

Leaving a 5" tail for stitching, ch4, yo, insert hook in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook and draw up a loop, ch 1 (it will help to pinch this chain to identify it for the next stitch), yo and complete as for dc

Yo, insert hook in pinched/marked st and draw up a loop, ch1 and complete as for dc (extended dc)

Counting 1<sup>st</sup> ch as 1 dc, continue for desired wrist size:  
26 (30,38) sts

Being careful not to twist foundation row, dc join by inserting hook from front to back through 1<sup>st</sup> ch4 (counts as a BPDC)

Front post double crochet (FPDC) around next dc, Back post double crochet around next dc (BPDC), and continue for 4-6 rounds or desired cuff length.

### Hand:

Back loop single crochet (blsc) in each dc around.

Work to 1-2" short of desired length.

*Decrease Round:* Work 5-7 scdec evenly spaced around

Work 2 rounds even.

Repeat these 3 rounds to desired length.

Stitch opening closed and weave in all ends.

## Finishing

Stitch opening closed, and weave in all ends.

### Options

Rose mitt alternate stitch pattern: 2sc in one st, sk 1 st, repeat around using 2<sup>nd</sup> of 2 sts for next round's placement.
