Sugar Bush Yarns Bliss  
1 ball Colorway shown is Violet Wash

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

approx 7" x 4" each

### HOOK & NOTIONS

Crochet Hook H, or 5mm  
Tapestry Needle

### GAUGE

approx 16 dc = 4"

### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** - chain  
**hdc** - half double crochet  
**dc** - double crochet  
**sc** - single crochet  
**tc** - triple crochet  
**sk** - skip

## DRAGONFLY FINGERLESS MITTS

### RIGHT HAND

Ch 32

ROW 1) Hdc in 3rd ch from hook. Hdc all across row. Ch 2, Turn.

ROW 2) Hdc all across. Ch 2, turn.

ROW 3) Hdc all across. Ch 3, turn. (30 st)

ROW 4) Dc 22, ch 1, sk next st, dc 7. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 5) Dc 4, ch 3, sk 3, sc in space, ch 3, sk 3, dc 19. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 6) Dc 18, ch 4, sk 1 stitch and the chains, sc 1 in sc below, ch 4, sk over the chains and 1 st, dc 3. Ch 3, turn.



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ROW 7) Dc 3, dc 4 in ch space, tc in sc below, dc 4 in ch space, dc 18. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 8) Sc all across. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 9) Dc 7, ch 1, sk 1, dc 22. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 10) Dc 19, ch 3, sk 3, sc in space, ch 3, sk 3, dc 4. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 11) Dc 3, ch 4, sk 1 st and the chains, sc 1 in sc below, sk chains and 1 st, dc 18. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 12) Dc 18, dc 4 in chain space, tc in sc below, dc 4 in chain space, dc 3. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 13) Sc all across.

ROWS 14-17) Repeat Rows 4-7, but on Row 17 at the end, ch 2, turn.

ROW 18) Hdc all across. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 19) Sc all across. Cut yarn tail about 6 inches long. Pull through loop.

## LEFT HAND

Ch 32

ROW 1) Hdc in 3rd chain from hook. Hdc all across row. Ch 2, turn.

ROW 2) Hdc all across. Ch 2, turn.

ROW 3) Hdc all across. Ch 3, turn. (30 st)

ROW 4) Dc 7, ch 1, sk 1, dc 22. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 5) Dc 18, ch 3, sk 3, sc in space, ch 3, sk 3, dc 5. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 6) Dc 3, ch 4, sk 1 st and chains, sc 1 in sc below, ch 4, sk chains and 1 st, dc 18. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 7) Dc 17, dc 4 in chain space, tc in sc below, dc 4 in chain space, dc 4. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 8) Sc all across. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 9) Dc 21, ch 1, sk 1, dc 8. Ch 3, turn,

ROW 10) Dc 4, ch 3, sk 3, sc 1 in space, ch 3, sk 3, dc 19. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 11) Dc 17, ch 4, sk 1 st and chains, sc 1 in sc below, ch 4, sk chains and next st, dc 4. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 12) Dc 3, dc 4 in chain space, tc in sc below, dc 4 in chain space, dc 18. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 13) Sc all across. Ch 3, turn.

ROWS 14-17) Repeat Rows 4-7, but on Row 17 at the end, ch 2, turn.

ROW 18) Hdc all across. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 19) Sc all across. Cut yarn tail about 6" long. Pull through loop.

## FINISHING:

With right sides together, use the 6" tail to sew the top of the mitt down approx 1 7/8-2"

Cut another piece of yarn about 10" long and seam to bottom of mitt, leaving a 2-2 1/4" opening for your thumb.

You can adjust the size of the opening to suit yourself.

Weave in ends. Turn right side out and enjoy!
