NOTES

Super easy effortless to wear shawl... enjoy!

YARN

Nikki's Hand Dye or Simplicity or 600 yards of DK weight

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

66" X 30

HOOKS & NOTIONS

H hook

ABBREVIATIONS

DC - double crochet

Ch - chain

Sts - Stitches

TRIANGLE GRADIENT SHAWL

To begin chain 8 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.

ROW 1: Ch 3 4 DC Ch 3 5 DC in the ring, Ch 3 turn

ROW 2: 2 DC in the first stitch, 1 DC in the next 4 sts. Work 2 DC in each of the Ch 3 spaces in the row below. Ch 3 and then 2 DC. 1 DC in the next 4 sts 3 DC in the top of the Ch 3 from the previous round.

ROW 3: Ch 3 1 DC into first st *Ch 1 skip a stitch, 1 dc into next st* Repeat until ch space at point, ch 1, dc, ch 3, 1 dc, ch. * 1 dc into next st, ch1 skip a stitch* repeat to last st 1 dc, ch1, 1 dc.

ROW 4: Chain 3, 2 dc into first st. *1 dc into each ch 1 space, 1 dc into next st* repeat until ch 3 space from previous row, work 2 dc, ch3, 2 dc. *1 dc into next st, 1dc into ch 1 space* repeat until ch3 space at the end, work 3 dc into ch3 space

Repeat these rows with each color change until shawl is as big as you want changing colors as you go.

Optional edges:

Picot Stitch-Ch2, slst in 1st ch



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
