Yarn Along the Rockies 2018

YARN

1 skein Brown Sheep company Lamb's Pride

GAUGE

5 stitches and 7 rounds = 1" worked in Stockinette stitch, in the round, on larger needles

NEEDLES & NOTIONS

Size 7 and 8 double pointed needles (or size needed to obtain gauge)

NEEDLES & NOTIONS

Size US 4 (3.5mm) needle or size needed to obtain fabric desired for yarn being used.

Cable needle

Stitch holder

Tapestry needle

CABLE ME MITTS

RIGHT MITTEN

*Cast on 36 stitches on smaller dpns, join in the round, PM and knit 2x2 rib (k2, p2) for 16 rounds.

Work 1 round of set up round (P3, K12, P3, K18) then switch to larger needles

Knit 3 more set up rounds.

Thumb gusset (R)

R1-P3, C6B, C6F, P3, K1, PM, M1, K1, M1, PM, K16 (38 Sts)

R 2-4- P3, K12, P3, K1, SM, K3, SM, K16

R 5- P3, K12, P3, K1, SM, M1, K3, M1, SM, K16 (40 Sts)

R 6- P3, K12, P3, K1, SM, K5, SM, K16

R 7- , C6B, C6F, P3, K1, SM, M1, K5, M1, SM, K16 (42 Sts)

R 8- P3, K12, P3, K1, SM, K7, SM, K16

R 9- P3, K12, P3, K1, SM, M1, K7, M1, SM, K16 (44 Sts)

R 10- P3, K12, P3, K1, SM, K9, SM, K16

R 11- P3, K12, P3, K1, SM, M1, K9, M1, SM, K16 (46 Sts)

R 12- P3, K12, P3, K1, SM, K11, SM, K16

R 13- P3, C6B, C6F, P3, K1, SM, M1, K11, M1, SM, K16 (48 Sts)

R-14- P3, K12, P3, K1, S 13 Sts between the 2 markers onto a stitch holder, CO 1 St, K16. You will now have 36 stitches on the needle and 13 thumb stitches on the holder. Continue working on the stitches on the needles.

R 15-18- P3, K12, P3, K18

R 19- P3, C6B, C6F, P3, K18

R 20-22- P3, K12, P3, K18

Switch to smaller needles

R 23- P3, K12, P3, K18

Work 4 rounds 2x2 rib and bind off using sewn bind off.

THUMB:

Using smaller needles, place the 13 thumb stitches on the needles, k 13 stitches, pick up 3 stitches and join in the round (16 sts)

Work 4 rounds 2x2 rib and Bo using the sewn BO

LEFT MITTEN

Work from * until thumb gusset

Thumb gusset (L)

R1- P3, C6B, C6F, P3, K16, PM, M1, K1, M1, PM, K1 (38 Sts)

R 2-4- P3, K12, P3, K16, SM, K3, SM, K1

R 5- P3, K12, P3, K16, SM, M1, K3, M1, SM, K1 (40 Sts)

R 6- P3, K12, P3, K16, SM, K5, SM, K1

R 7- , C6B, C6F, P3, K16, SM, M1, K5, M1, SM, K1 (42 Sts)

R 8- P3, K12, P3, K16, SM, K7, SM, K1

R 9- P3, K12, P3, K16, SM, M1, K7, M1, SM, K1 (44 Sts)

R 10- P3, K12, P3, K16, SM, K9, SM, K1

R 11- P3, K12, P3, K16, SM, M1, K9, M1, SM, K1 (46 Sts)

R 12- P3, K12, P3, K16, SM, K11, SM, K1

R 13- P3, C6B, C6F, P3, K16, SM, M1, K11, M1, SM, K1 (48 Sts)

R-14- P3, K12, P3, K16, S 13 Sts between the 2 markers onto a stitch holder, CO 1 St, K1. You will now have 36 stitches on the needle and 13 thumb stitches on the holder. Continue working on the stitches on the needles.

R 15-18- P3, K12, P3, K18

R 19- P3, C6B, C6F, P3, K18

R 20-22- P3, K12, P3, K18

Switch to smaller needles

R 23- P3, K12, P3, K18

Work 4 rounds 2x2 rib and bind off using sewn bind off.

THUMB:

Using smaller needles, place the 13 thumb stitches on the needles, k 13 stitches, pick up 3 stitches and join in the round (16 sts)

Work 4 rounds 2x2 rib and Bo using the sewn BO
