



Quandary Peak Rolled Brim Hat - Yarn Along the Rockies 2019

Finished Size - Adult

Yarn - 1 skein Malabrigo Washted (210 yards/192 m each) sample used color 684, Camaleon.

Needles and notions - size US 7 (4.5mm) x 16" circular needles and double-pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
5 stitch markers
Darning needle to finish.

Gauge - Approx. 22 sts = 4" in stockinette stitch

Abbreviations: k = knit; p = purl; k2tog = knit 2 together; p2tog = purl 2 together



Cast on 95 sts, join to knit in the round

Rounds 1 - 6: k all stitches

Round 7: p1, k94

Round 8: p 2, k 93

Round 9: p3, k 92

Round 10 p4, k 91

Work all the following rounds by purling one more stitch than the previous round, and knitting one less stitch than the previous round, until hat measures 8 ¼" from cast-on edge, complete one more round in established pattern, placing stitch markers every 19 stitches

Decrease Rounds: note, Change to Double pointed needles when necessary

First decrease round: Continue in established pattern (purling and knitting) until 2 sts. Before marker, p2tog, or k2tog (as established, when you encounter a purl and a knit stitch that need to be worked together - p2tog.

Continue decrease round, and, at the same time purl one more stitch each round throughout the remaining rows of your hat, until 5 stitches remain.

Finishing: Break yarn, leaving an 8" tail With darning needle, thread tail through all 5 stitches and Pull tightly. Weave in ends and wet or steam block as desired.
